Dear Kendall Greens Parent and Student,

Welcome to the 2023-2024 academic year. I hope this letter finds you well and having a wonderful and relaxing summer. Please read this email **completely** as it contains important information, dates and tasks that need to be completed before the new school year begins.

The first day of school is Thursday, August 17th!

Parent Open House is on Wednesday, August 16 from 1:00 p.m. – 3:30 p.m. Parents and students will have an opportunity to meet teachers. Stay tuned for more information about session times and details. See our Instagram page for details.

High School Schedules:

The schedule was developed based on your credit needs from your academic record. Every effort was made to keep open courses on the Apex platform but please be advised that the school is transitioning to a new instructional platform where students will now access their academic classes, **Edmentum**. Most classes will now be available through Edmentum and Apex should be depleted by the end of the school year.

Please be aware that there is not a great deal of flexibility in the schedule, as we can only open five classes at a time. All schedule change requests will be addressed within the first two weeks of school. If you would like to review your schedule, or have a question or concern, your advisory teacher will have an “Academic Counseling Form” please fill out and return to Advisory teacher and she will submit to Mrs. Perez, your assistant principal.

Class Assignment:

Most returning students will remain in their original class. However, some students have been changed based on new enrollment, intervention needs, and passing scores on state assessments. Class schedules will be posted outside on the first day of school.

Books and Backpacks:

As a reminder, textbooks are not required as Kendall Greens provides a virtual academic curriculum. Students will be provided with a Student Binder by their classroom teachers during the first week of class. Pens and paper are always available in class, students are encouraged to bring a notebook for notetaking. Backpacks and medium/large purses are **NOT** allowed into the building. Only small purses are allowed for ladies.

Electronic Devices and Cell Phones:

Keep in mind that students will use desktops and laptops available in the classroom. These have to access digital textbooks, novels, and other approved instructional applications used as supplemental resources. **Cell phones are NOT considered an appropriate device and are NOT permitted for use inside the classroom and are collected at student entry.** Parents and students will also be required to sign an acceptable use policy form.

We do ask that students bring a set of headphones with a cord as our virtual curriculum has videos and can read lessons aloud. Students can only access these features with corded headphones.

Attendance

As a reminder our school has two sessions, **a.m. or p.m.** Doors open at 7:00 a.m. for our morning session and students are considered **late at 7:30 a.m.** Dismissal is at 12:00 p.m. Doors open at 12:30 p.m. for our afternoon session and students are considered **late at 1:00 p.m.** **Kendall Greens follows the same Miami-Dade County Public Schools** attendance and truancy policies. Absences must be reported to the school and a signed parent note must be submitted upon return to campus. Students with excessive absences will receive appropriate consequences and interventions, possible loss of a.m. session registration, and withdrawal consideration if necessary.

Dress Code

Students are required to dress appropriately for school. As a reminder, the following is **NOT** permissible to wear: hoodies, pajamas, slides sandals, jeans or pants with rips/tears above the knee, cut off shirts, tube tops, short shorts/skirts, spaghetti straps, anything displaying profanity, drug paraphernalia, sagging pants/shorts, hats, and head/face coverings.

Students **CAN** wear: shorts (medium length), jeans, any colored pants, dresses, skirts, crocs, sneakers, sweatshirts/jackets without a hood, T-shirts and polos. Come dressed to impress!

As a reminder to all students and parents, if the student is not planning on returning to Kendall Greens High School for the 2023-2024 school year, you must visit the school in person to sign a withdrawal form.
