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Dear Kendall Greens Parent and Student,

**Welcome to the 2024-2025 academic year**, I hope this letter finds you well. Please read this email completely as it contains important information, dates and tasks that need to be completed before the new school year begins.

**The first day of school is Thursday, August 15th**

**The Parent Open House is on Wednesday, August 14 from 1:00 p.m. – 3:30 p.m.** Parents and students will have an opportunity to meet teachers. Stay tuned for more information about session times and details. See our Instagram page for details.

### **High School Schedules:**

Students will access their courses online through the Edmentum program, which is not available from home. All schedule change requests will be addressed within the first two weeks of school. If you would like to review your schedule, or have a question or concern, your advisory teacher will have an “*Academic Counseling Form*” please fill out and return it to Advisory teacher. Your assistant principal will meet with you at the beginning of the year.

### **Class Assignment**

Most returning students will remain in their original class. However, some students have been changed based on new enrollment, intervention needs, and passing scores on state assessments. Class schedules will be posted at student entry on the first day of school.

### **Books and Backpacks**

As a reminder, textbooks are not required as Kendall Greens provides a virtual academic curriculum. Students will be provided with a Student Binder by their classroom teachers during the first week of class. Pens and paper are always available in class, students are encouraged to bring a notebook for notetaking. Backpacks and medium/large purses are NOT allowed into the building. Only small purses are allowed for ladies.

### **Electronic Devices and Cell Phones**

Keep in mind that students will use desktops and laptops available in the classroom. These must access digital textbooks, novels, and other approved instructional applications used as supplemental resources. Cell phones are NOT considered an appropriate device and are NOT permitted for use inside the classroom and are collected at student entry. Parents and students will also be required to sign an acceptable use policy form.

## **Headphones**

We do ask that students bring a set of headphones with a cord as our virtual curriculum has videos and can read lessons aloud. Students can only access these features with corded headphones.

## **Attendance**

As a reminder our school has two sessions, a.m. y p.m. Doors open at 7:00 a.m. for our morning session and students are considered late at 7:30 a.m. Dismissal is at 12:00 p.m. Doors open at 12:30 p.m. for our afternoon session and students are considered late at 1:00 p.m. Kendall Greens follows the same Miami-Dade County Public Schools attendance and truancy policies. Absences must be reported to the school and a signed parent note must be submitted upon return to campus within 48 hours of absence. Students with excessive absences will receive appropriate consequences and interventions, possible loss of a.m. session registration, and withdrawal consideration if necessary.

## **Dress Code**

**Acceptable:** Students are required to dress appropriately for school. As a reminder, the following is NOT permissible attire: *hoodies, pajamas, slides, sandals, jeans with rips/tears above the knee, cut off shirts, tube tops, biker shorts/skirts, spaghetti straps, anything displaying profanity, drug paraphernalia, sagging pants/shorts, hats, and head/face coverings of any kind.*

**Not Acceptable:** The following is permissible attire: *shorts (medium length), jeans, any colored pants, sweet pants, dresses, skirts, crocs, sneakers, sweatshirts/jackets without a hood, t-shirts and polos.*

## **School IDs**

A school ID will be provided within the first two weeks of school, and students must wear it to school daily. Students will not be allowed in the building without an ID after one has been issued.

## **Withdrawals**

As a reminder to all students and parents, if the student is not planning on returning to Kendall Greens High School for the 2024-2025 school year, you must visit the school in person to sign a withdrawal form.
